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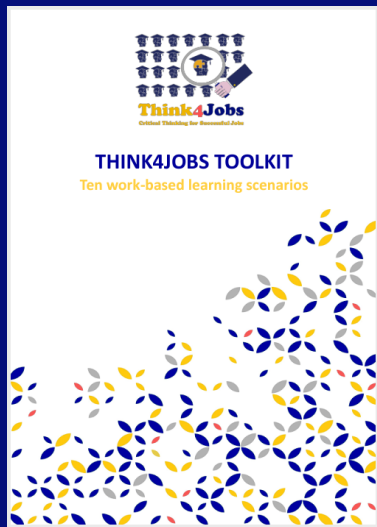


# A preview from our work

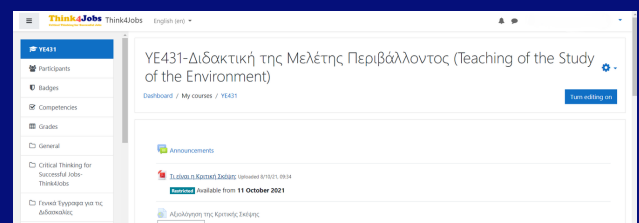
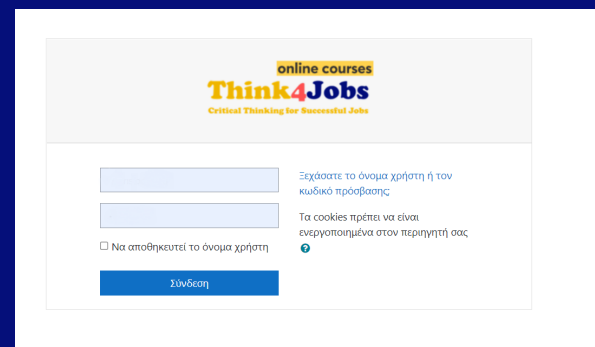

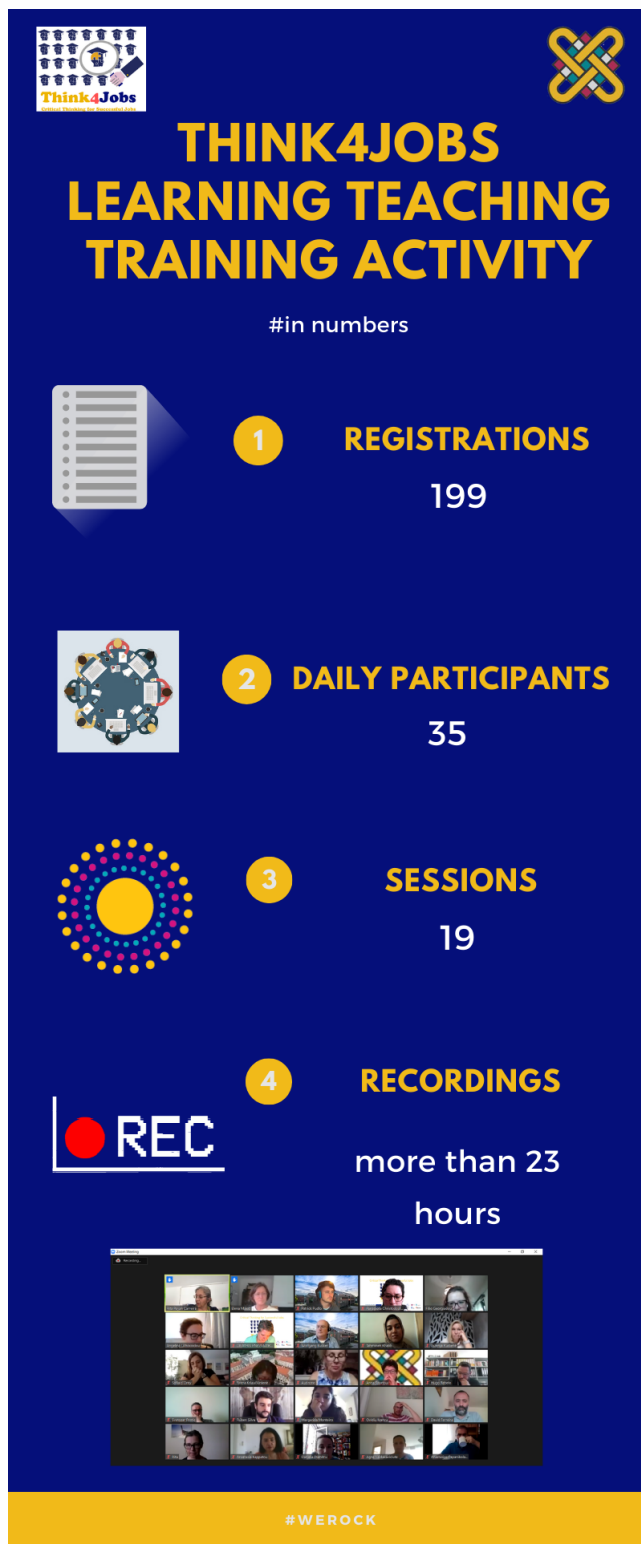

Our project reached another landmark, as we completed successfully the Learning Teaching Training Activity. Have a look at our infographic!

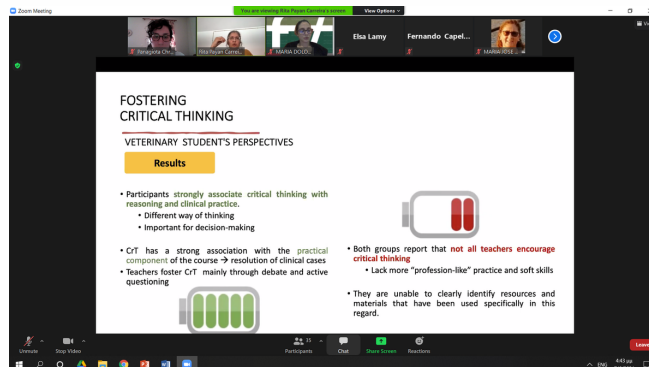


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# Dissemination actions

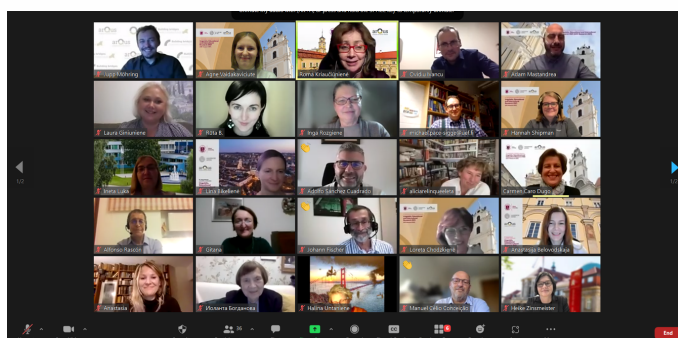
The University of Evora and the University of Western Macedonia presented the project at the "II International Congress of Education in Animal Sciences (ICEAS)".
